Myanmar: Suu Kyi Runs For A Parliament Seat

Democracy activist and Nobel Peace Prize winner Aung San Suu Kyi registered Wednesday to run for a parliamentary seat in the military-run country. Suu Kyi will contest for a seat in Kawhmu, where supporters clapped and gave her flowers after she turned in her paperwork for the April election.

Pakistan: Two Aid Workers Kidnapped

At least three gunmen have kidnapped two foreign aid workers. The aid workers, one German and one Italian, had just returned to their home Thursday in Multan after helping victims of the 2010 flood in the outskirts of the city when the gunmen forced their way inside their house. The kidnapping took place inside an enclosed community that houses mostly military offices but some civilian homes.

Mexico: A Ray Of Hope For Juarez

For years, Ciudad Juarez has been known as Mexico's murder capital. Last year, there were 1,933 violent deaths in Juarez, according to the Chihuahua state attorney's office. But 2011 is the first time since 2007 that the number of murders went down. Some businesses that had closed are opening back up.

Italy: Rescuers Resume Search On Cruise Ship

At least 11 people are known to have died in the disaster, and 21 are still missing, according to the Italian Crisis Unit. A week after the ship ran aground off the Tuscan coast, it appears increasingly unlikely that any further survivors will still be found aboard the ship.

Egypt: Muslims Burn Christian Homes & Shops

A Muslim mob attacked Copts today, destroying and torching their homes, straw huts and shops. According to reports, security forces were present but did not intervene and the fire brigade arrived 90 minutes late. An eye-witness said that a straw hut belonging to a Copt was torched to clear the area for a mosque. There are more than 300 mosques in the village and one church.

N Korea: Seven Underground Churches Raided
